<b>What is SUmmit?</b>	
<p><a href="#">SUmmit</a> is an SU committee made up of a range of student leaders and representatives who vote to create <a href="#">Standpoints</a> (SU stances on any given issue) and hold the SU Officers to account.</p> <p><b>SUmmit Functions</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To discuss, agree, and amend proposed Standpoints.</li> <li>• To discuss topical issues related to the student experience.</li> <li>• To receive updates from SU Officers and ask relevant questions regarding Officer work.</li> <li>• To provide insight and direction for the Officer team and other relevant representatives on key issues.</li> <li>• To receive updates from student groups, project teams, or other groups of students on campaigns, projects, and other pieces of work that may be of interest to SUmmit's members.</li> <li>• Create a network of student leaders and encourage collaboration between areas.</li> </ul>	
<b>Role Summary</b>	
A SUmmit member is elected to the SUmmit Committee at the beginning of each academic year <b>OR</b> is invited onto the committee due to their existing role in The SU (e.g., Exec member).	
<p><b>Duties and Responsibilities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Attend and participate at up to five SUmmit meetings per year.</li> <li>• Communicate with the SU Officers about their updates and work relating to standpoints.</li> <li>• Consider standpoint proposals and discuss these at the committee with the proposer(s).</li> <li>• Vote on Standpoints virtually following a SUmmit meeting.</li> <li>• Engage in committee functions and ask SU Officers questions relating to their work.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Time Commitment:</b></p> <p>One academic year minimum.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Four 2-hour SUmmit meetings across the academic year</li> <li>• Requires some reading of proposals and information outside of meeting times.</li> <li>• Any additional planning and preparation time.</li> <li>• One to two hours of training at beginning of Semester 1.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Expectations of SUmmit members</b></p> <p>If you are a member of SUmmit, there are several responsibilities you are expected to fulfil, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sending apologies if you cannot attend a meeting.</li> <li>• Voting on all Standpoint proposals.</li> <li>• Considering the view of the group/Exec you represent (if applicable).</li> </ul> <p><b>Please note:</b> SUmmit's full membership list will be accessible to SU members via our website.</p> <p>You can read more about expectations of SUmmit members in the SUmmit Terms of Reference online.</p>	
<p><b>Venue:</b></p> <p>SUmmit meetings will usually be held in person.</p>	<p><b>Training:</b></p> <p>In-house training provided by The SU.</p>
