This BATH Girl Can Week is all about encouraging and empowering women to be active in sport and physical activity during their time at University and beyond.

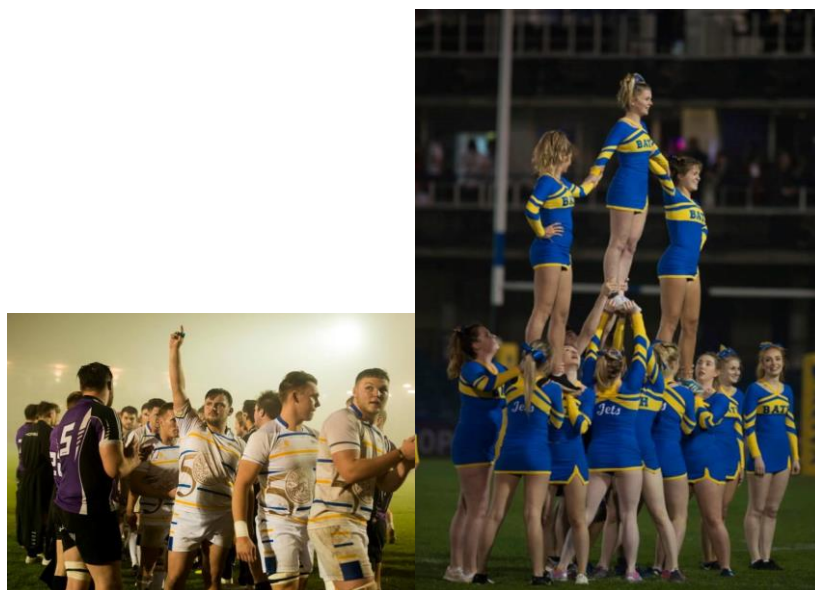
